The Cal/OSHA Program is responsible for enforcing California laws and regulations pertaining to workplace safety and health and for providing assistance to employers and workers about workplace safety and health issues.

[Cal/OSHA Consultation Service](#) provides assistance to employers and workers about workplace safety and health issues through on-site assistance, high hazard consultation and special emphasis programs, and develops educational materials on workplace safety and health topics. Consultative assistance is provided to employers through on-site visits, telephone support, [publications](#) and educational outreach. All services provided by Cal/OSHA Consultation are provided free of charge to California employers.
